iCARE aims to remove barriers to healthcare and social services for vulnerable groups, including elderly people, persons with disabilities, children, and citizens with chronic conditions or high-risk health profiles. The project addresses shared challenges across the Programme Area, such as rural isolation, low digital health literacy, limited availability of health e-services, and existing inequalities in access to primary care. Key deliverables include: Launching telemedicine and electronic health record systems; Acquiring mobility aids and electric vehicles for homecare; Piloting healthcare and social e-services; Conducting training workshops and seminars for healthcare professionals.
